Constitution Amendment Ratification

The 2018 Convention approved nine amendments to the Constitution of Tau Beta Pi and sent it to the chapters for ratification. In accord with the Association's amending procedure, with 292 chapters (248 collegiate and 44 alumni) eligible to vote, 219 or more affirmative chapter votes are required to ratify an amendment, and 73 or more negative votes would defeat it.

Headquarters received 200 valid ballots by the voting deadline of April 1, 2019 (plus 23 invalid for lack of a chapter quorum). An additional 10 valid ballots (plus 4 invalid) were received after the deadline prior to the Executive Council meeting. The Council acted on April 10 and voted on behalf of those chapters submitting an invalid ballot or no ballot. The ratified amendments are effective now.

AMENDMENT

- 1. Require programs that are not ABET-EAC accredited or have the same name as an ABET-EAC accredited program to be appealed and approved by the Convention. (Const. Art. II, Sec. 1(a)(3))
- 2. Clarify that an institution or advisor determines scholastic eligibility for graduate students. (Const. Art. II, Sec. 3(a))
- 3. Adjust when the Advisory Board approves graduate student eligibility and when documents are submitted. (Const. Art. II, Sec. 3(b))
- 4. Clarify a District Director's role in mediating a candidate's objection to duties assigned by a chapter. (Const. Art. III, Sec. 2(b))
- 5. Update the language and refine the process for the petitioning and approval of new collegiate chapters. (Const. Art. VI, Secs. 1-3)
- 6. Allow the Convention and Executive Council to modify official and trial programs, respectively. (Const. Art. IX, Section 7(f) and Art. X, Sec. 5(k))
- 7. Change the deadline for Executive Council nominations to July 1. (Const. Art. X, Sec. 2(a))
- 8. Adjust when Executive Council nominations are allowed from the floor of Convention. (Const. Art. X, Sec. 2(d))
- 9. Refine the Executive Council election process to address situations where an unopposed candidate does not receive a majority vote. (Const. Art. X, Sec. 3(a))

OUTCOME
