Officers gathered at Crescent Lawn and drove to the Golden Gate Park for a day excursion. We situated ourselves on the field and carried out some crafting activities such as bracelet making, coloring books and folding origami stars while getting to know each other. Then we had a picnic and set off back to Berkeley, where we carried out our semesterly retreat meeting. We also met up with some alumni.

Purpose

For everyone to meet and get to know each other, especially after a couple of virtual semesters. The retreat meeting's goal is to get a gauge of what each committee is planning for, and how much they are looking to spend to help with budgeting.

Organization

Activities committee organized the food part of retreat. They also assisted in looking for lodging when we were still considering overnight stays. The alumni were consulted since the president has never been on an in-person TBP retreat, and advised us on matters such as lodging, activities and cost.

Cost

\$271.43 + \$50 (mistakenly bought botanical garden tickets)

\$208 covered by officers.

Problems

After polling, the plan was to go to Clear Lake initially. However, there was a terrible algae bloom which forced us to relocate to Lake Tahoe/Carson City. Then, the wild fires near Lake Tahoe made the air quality horrible, so we had to consider alternatives. By then, it was too late to look for overnight stays and lodging, so we opted for a day excursion at Golden Gate Park. Certainly felt like the odds were stacked against this retreat. The president also made an error with the gathering point – it was a ticket-gated area which was not anticipated. So there was a relocation to a freely accessible field. We initially booked Soda 306 for the meeting, but the room required a metal key which we did not acquire beforehand because the booking websites stated that physical keys were no longer being issued. . . Luckily we booked a second backup location and successfully held the meeting in the Social Sciences Building.

Results

Many officers noted that having a day excursion instead of a whole weekend trip was much appreciated. It's an option that's certainly worth considering in the future since it alleviates a lot of stress. A lot of socializing happened and officers seemed to get to know each other better after the retreat, so it was a relative success considering all the mishaps that occurred along the way.

Purpose

To facilitate off campus officer bonding while having fun!

Organization

long report incoming

(Retreat Housing): Put together a shortlist of 4 locations (Sacramento, Lake Tahoe, Yosemite, Monterey) and sent out to officers, picked a final location based on majority voting (Yosemite). Looked through Airbnb, Vrbo, etc. to find housing. Since it was vacation season, there weren't a lot of affordable options left close to Yosemite, so I looked in nearby cities (Mariposa); also, the WiFi situation was better further away. Important Factors: proximity of landlord, how strict they were about number of people (most were extra strict bc of COVID), carpeted floors, WiFi. Found a decent place (3000 sq. ft, 18 ppl max, 5828 Sherlock Road, Midpines, CA 95345) and booked it about 1 month before the retreat date. Offered to pay for the extra people but they never got back to me. Also bought trip cancellation and damage protection.

Once housing was set, I sent out an RSVP form: impt questions = 21+, driver info (do they have a car? do they have experience driving in the snow?), allergies, earliest time they could leave for retreat, if they had a sleeping bag/blankets they could bring

(Driving Logistics): From the RSVP responses, I chose Franky, Constance, and Amy as drivers since they all had their own cars already. We needed 3 more drivers; I prioritized people 21+ (for car rental purposes) who had experience driving in snow. For people without experience driving in snow, I put someone in their car who did. I chose James, Yufan, and Oscar as the other 3 drivers and ordered 3 midsize cars from Enterprise using the UC Berkeley discount code (UCBGEN) using their contact info. Scheduled for pickup at the San Pablo Enterprise, but had to schedule dropoff at Oakland Airport since the San Pablo location is closed on weekends. I organized cars based on people's RSVP responses for departure times + one Act car to go food shopping.

(Before Retreat): I sent out a Retreat Guide Google Doc detailing the itinerary, impt info, car assignments, and a suggested shopping list about a week in advance. I required everyone to send me a COVID test taken the week of. I made sure everyone knew their sleeping situation so they could prepare accordingly. I also gave committees a heads up to prepare retreat slides and shared a master doc with them to add to. I reached out to alumni to let them know our retreat plans, but none of them responded so we didn't have any join us :(

(Activity Planning): We were planning on arriving by Friday afternoon-night and leaving Sunday morning, so the bulk of activities needed to be planned for Saturday. Act planned/bought all meals which was super helpful.

– Friday: The plan was for people to arrive by nighttime so we could all eat dinner together. Activities planned a fun scavenger hunt icebreaker and we did some brief casual introductions. For the sleeping situation, drivers got first pick for beds, while I assigned people who got beds in advance based on their RSVP responses. Everyone else I told to bring their sleeping bags/blankets, and we slept on the floor (which was carpeted).

– Saturday: I researched things to do in Yosemite and came up with a few options for officers. I sent out (yet another) Google Form asking for people's preferences for some snow activities (skiing/snowboarding, ice skating, hiking). I reached out to Yosemite to see if we could get discounts, but we needed at least 20 people to go skiing/snowboarding to get a minimal discount so it wasn't that useful.

This part was a massive headache: I wasn't able to find affordable snow chain rentals for all 6 cars + there can be legal issues with putting snow chains on rental cars + I didn't realize there were already snow chains in the TBP office, so I had to find an alternative way to get to Yosemite instead of just driving in directly. I found a YART station (Yosemite Cedar Lodge in El Portal) about halfway b/t the cabin and Yosemite; I decided the drivers would park there and we would all take the YART into Yosemite. I booked bus tickets for everyone based on how early and late they wanted to arrive/leave Yosemite (also collected

on the snow activities Google Form). I organized rides to and from the bus stop based on these responses. I also figured out various shuttle stops within Yosemite leading to the different activities.

People ended up splitting into ~4 groups: a 6am (cabin departure) hiking group, a 8am hiking group, a chill hiking group, and a skiing/snowboarding group. Once everyone got back to the cabin, we ate dinner, had retreat meeting, and had a fun officer social.

– Sunday: We cleaned up the house, ate breakfast, and left; rental drivers had to then drop off cars at Oakland Airport, so I had Constance drive them all back to Berkeley.

(After Retreat): I tracked people down to pay the \$40 per person fee, and worked on getting reimbursements out with David.

Cost

\$1476.27 for the house (including insurance), \$660 for 3 rentals (2 days), ~\$500 for food, \$378 for bus tickets, gas reimbursements

Total: ~\$3580

Officers (26 total) paid \$40 each (\$1040), we covered the rest

Problems

Getting to the cabin: There were issues getting the rental cars, it seemed to be on Enterprise's end (understaffed), so the rental cars ended up getting to the cabin pretty late. Only the Act car and my car got there in the afternoon, but it worked out since we had time to meal prep for Saturday's lunch + Act set up the icebreaker activities.

Going to/from Yosemite: See Organization for issues with snow chains. A lot of people changed their minds on when they wanted to get to and leave Yosemite day of. Getting to the bus stop worked out, but a bunch of drivers wanted to stay in Yosemite longer, so some people got stranded at the bus stop for an hour on the way back. Luckily there was an open hotel lobby that they could chill in while they waited.

Snow Activities: The skiing/snowboarding area had to be reached by shuttle; they decreased shuttle services but the new schedule wasn't obvious when I looked it up. The skiing group ended up missing the shuttle going there anyway, but they wouldn't have been able to make it back in time for the bus had they gone. Luckily they found other things to do and still had fun (hopefully).

Misc: The cabin kept running out of hot water which was not ideal. It was a little far from Yosemite, but there weren't many other options that were in budget/had WiFi at that point.

Results

While planning was ~an ordeal~ + things inevitably will go wrong, I think overall it was a success! It was really nice getting to finally meet almost all of the officers (for the first time in my TBP experience), and officers actually got to know each other and bond. This semester has already been going much more smoothly than I expected, and I think it's partially because people actually know each other. Even while putting out fires constantly, I (somehow) managed to have fun too. Act did a great job organizing icebreakers + food + cooking from scratch (Sat night's chili was bomb!). The cabin was on the older side, but the facilities were clean and there was plenty of room, games, and amenities. I got a lot of positive feedback from officers, and I think people just appreciated getting a weekend getaway and touching grass for once.

Description

Pi day social with pie, pizza, and a pi-themed team challenge. We had the candidates split into groups of roughly five, then challenged them to create a network of 1-ohm resistors with a resistance as close to pi as they could in 20 minutes. The winning group each received a TBP shirt. Then we had a short trivia game with questions relating to pi. Afterwards we had pie and Sliver's Pizza.

Purpose

Social for the candidates, and some fun pi-day activities with pie.

Organization

We drew inspiration for the resistor challenge from a problem in the 2014 fall Bent Brain Ticklers, but adapted it to be better suited to a time-limited, group challenge environment. Each member wrote one or two trivia questions, although we did not decide beforehand how to fairly score the bonus question (write as many digits of pi as you can). We ended up doing three points for each regular question, and then round the square root of how many pi digits were given – although in the future we should specify this beforehand, especially if there is a better reward than first slice of pie. Nick and Constance made a pie, and we got the others from safeway and we got the pizza from Sliver's.

Cost

~ \$275 for pizza and pie.

Problems

We had ice cream to garnish the pie, however after the games, the ice cream had melted. Additionally, the winning group for the resistor challenge had 3 officers and only 2 candidates – for similar events in the future (with sufficient attendance) consider splitting into groups by house and awarding house points to the victor. Also, for the trivia we collected the answers from people who were confident and scored them ourselves which took more time than expected, and contributed to running beyond the specified time bounds of the event – so some people may have had to leave before the pie if they had other commitments after the set end time; we should have had the candidates score their own trivia.

Results

Overall the event was successful. The candidates seemed to enjoy the resistor game and trivia, although they may have lost some interest after one group created a very good circuit (even though better circuits were still possible). The pie and pizza were also a hit, although we had one leftover pizza (vegan). Attendance was high, although there were a few more people signed up than attended. We also exceeded the time bounds we posted for the event – we did not begin eating until roughly the posted end time. The circuit challenge took roughly
