

Tau Beta Pi Announces New Director of Alumni Affairs

Knoxville, TN — Tau Beta Pi, The Engineering Honor Society, has named a Director of Alumni Affairs, **Sean Aiton**, NC A '22, structural analysis engineer at Spirit Aerosystems. The Director of Alumni Affairs is responsible for engaging and supporting alumni members and chapters, guiding the formation of new alumni chapters, and organizing events.



Aiton earned his B.S. in aerospace engineering and M.S. in mechanical engineering from North Carolina State University where he was a researcher for the mechanical and aerospace engineering department.
