FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

Established in 1929, the **Fellowship Program** recognizes and supports outstanding members who plan to pursue graduate education that advances the engineering profession. Tau Beta Pi plans to award at least 30 fellowships this year. In 2025, 31 members received fellowships from 376 applicants.

Fellowships are awarded on the basis of scholarship, leadership and service, and the promise of substantial achievement. Applicants are asked to share their motivation and preparation for advanced study and how their career goals advance the interest of the engineering profession.

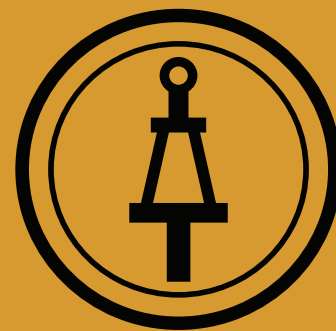
Applications are welcome from members or **candidates for membership who will be initiated by May 1** and will be enrolled full-time in a graduate program beginning Fall 2026. Applications are available at www.tbp.org/Applications.

Fellowship winners will be announced in May. Recipients will be awarded **\$10,000** in three installments beginning August 2026 and are required to submit a report summarizing their work at the completion of the fellowship year.

Fellowships are restricted to initiated members. They are awarded \$10,000 in three installments. Fellows may enroll in a graduate program in any field which enables them to contribute to the engineering profession. One fellowship (Best) is available for students pursuing an MBA at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (NYG).
