SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Established in 1998, the **Scholarship Program** will recognize and award members with funds in support of their senior year of undergraduate study. In 2025, 254 scholarships from 532 applicants were presented.

Scholarships are given on the basis of academic achievement, extracurricular activities, and the promise of substantial contributions to the engineering profession.

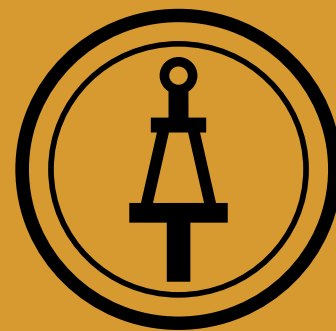
Applications are welcome from members or **candidates for membership who will be initiated by June 1**. Recipients must be full-time undergraduate engineering students during the 2026-27 academic year. Full-time students graduating in the fall semester are eligible for partial scholarships. One letter of recommendation is required. Applications, instructions, and FAQs are available at www.tbp.org/scholarships.cfm.

Scholarship winners will be announced in July. Scholars will receive one **\$2,000** payments in mid-September. Partial scholarships will instead receive **\$1,000**.

Scholarships are restricted to initiated members planning to return to school as seniors for at least one semester of full-time undergraduate study. Each full-year award is \$2,000. Partial scholarships of \$1,000 will be awarded for one semester.
